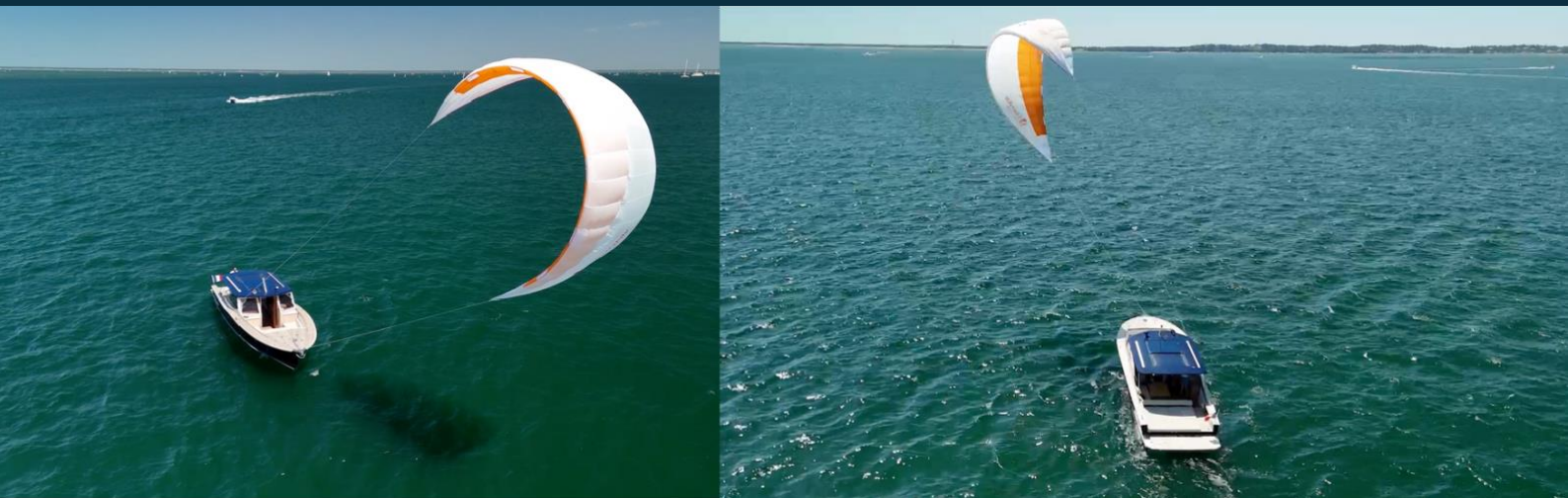

It reduces fuel consumption, extends the range of vessels, and provides a reliable solution in the event of engine failure or long crossings.
